1. Collection

Collection of post-industrial or post-consumer plastic waste.



2. Preparation

Preparation of plastic waste. Large products will be cut by an operator and loaded onto the conveyor belt feeding the shredder and/or grinder.



3. Densification

We are equipped with a densifier to optimise the density of light products.



4. Homogenisation

This stage is essential to ensure batch-to-batch stability.



5. Pelletisation

After pelletisation, the plastic resembles a small granule. The pelletisers filter down to 80 microns, guaranteeing impeccable quality.



6. Packaging

Finished products are packed in Big Bags, 25 kg bags or silo trucks.



7. Quality control

Quality control is carried out at every stage of the production process.



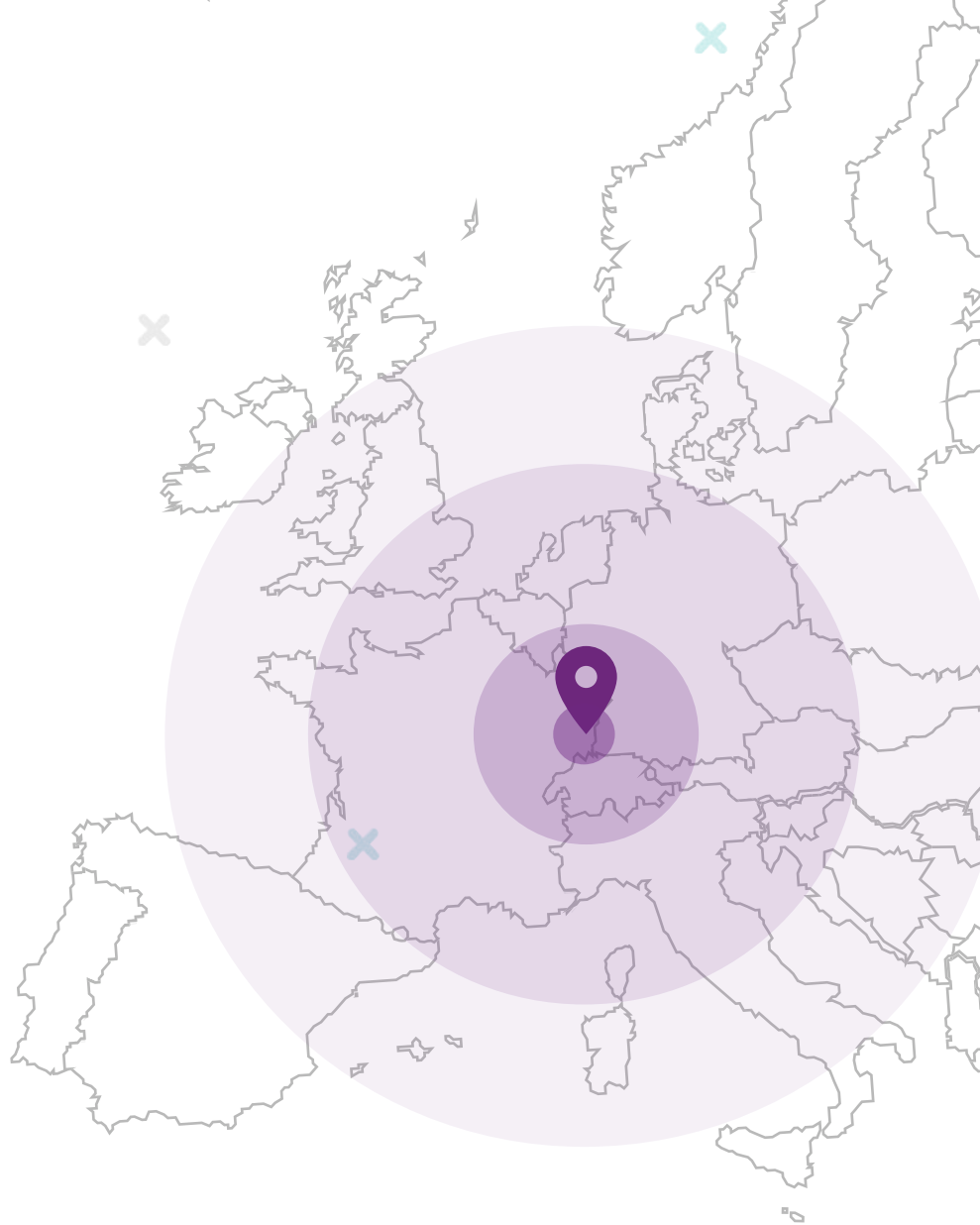
